

1. Where does the word *jeans* come from?


→ The word *jeans* comes from a kind of material that was made in Europe.

4. Why did more and more people begin wearing *jeans* in the 1970s?

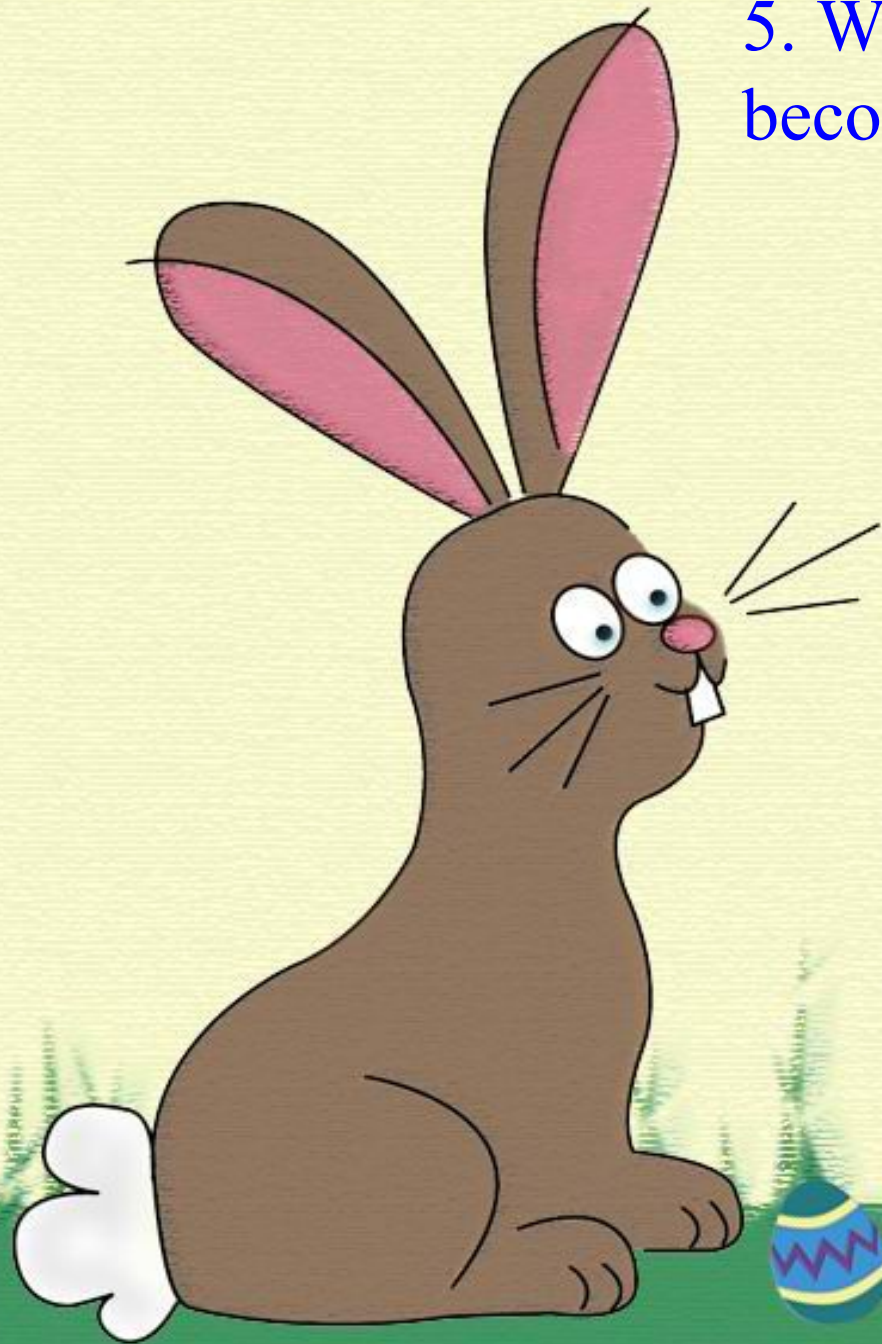
