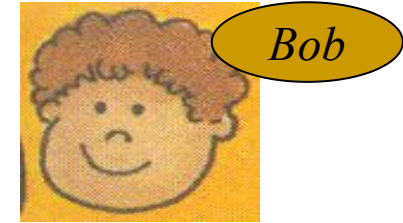
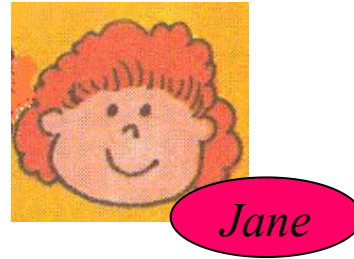
Jane (USA)
