Task2: Put the pictures of the events in the order they happened in the story



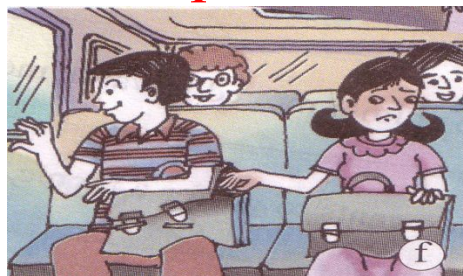

“How did you pay for it?” he asked.

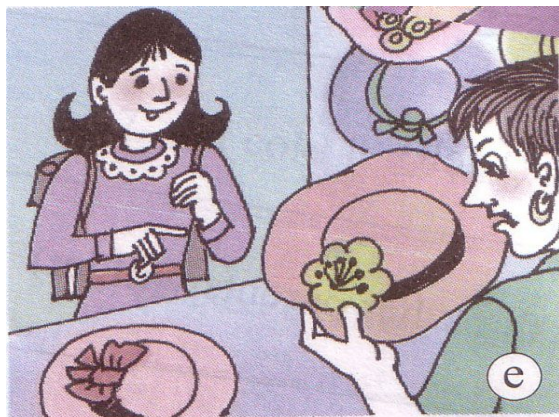
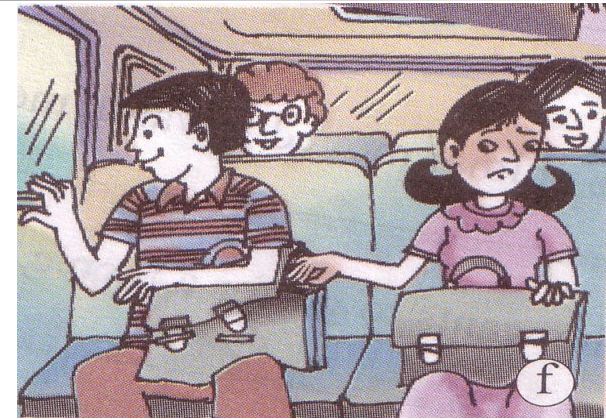
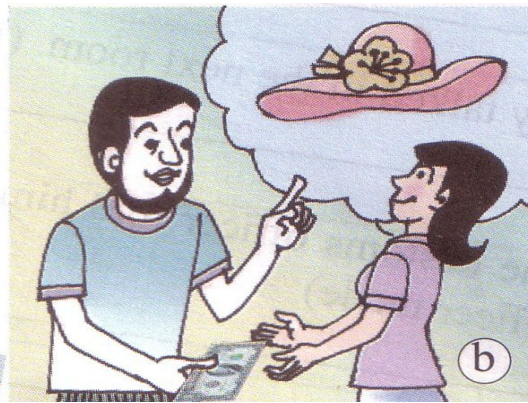
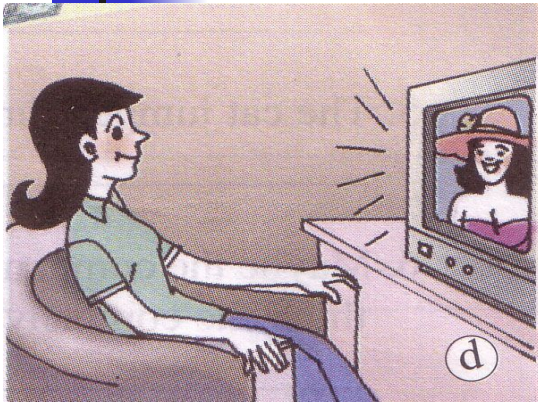
