## II. Grammar: Conditional sentences

### Examples:

If I have money, I will buy that house.

If he were me, he would do like that.

If she had studied hard, she wouldn't have failed in the exams.



# Forms and uses

Type	If clause	Main Clause	Uses
<b>I</b>	S + V <sup>0</sup> <sub>s/es</sub> (BE = am/is/are)	S + will + V <sub>0</sub> .....	<i>may happen</i>
<b>II</b>	S + V <sup>2</sup> <sub>ed</sub> (BE = WERE)	S + would + V <sub>0</sub> could	<i>Untrue at the present/ in the future</i>
<b>III</b>	S + had + V <sup>3</sup> <sub>ed</sub>	S + would have + V <sup>3</sup> <sub>ed</sub> could	<i>Untrue in the past</i>

## \* Sentence Transformation

She **doesn't** eat more **because** she **is** full

→ If she **weren't** full, she **would** eat more

He **didn't** do homework, **so** he **was** punished

→ If he **had** done homework, he **wouldn't** have been punished

## **\* Ways to transform:**

### **1. Notice the tense of verb**

**- Present tense → Use Condi. Type II**

**- Past tense → Use Condi. Type III**

### **2. Notice the clause**

**- SO (clause of result) → Main clause**

**- BECAUSE (clause of reason) → IF clause**

### **3. - NOT (No, never) → cross out**

**- Without NOT → add NOT**

**Example:**

We **get** lost **because** we **have no** map.

→ If we **had** map we **wouldn't get** lost.

He **didn't get** up early, **so** he **was** late for school.

→ If he **had got** up early, he **wouldn't have been** late for school.

2. He couldn't have time because he was busy.

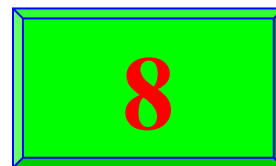
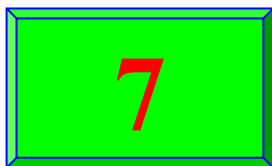
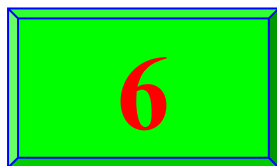
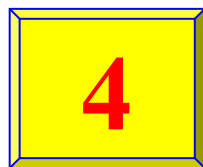
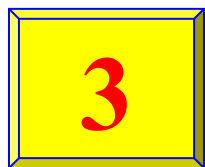
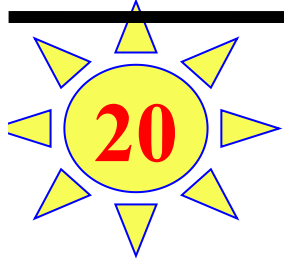
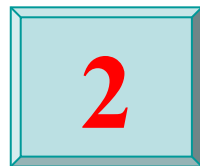
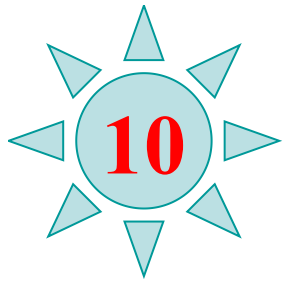
→ He would have had time if he hadn't been busy
