





Forms

- \mathfrak{B} 1: S + V + short adj/adv + ER and short adj/adv + ER
- €2: S + V + more and more + long adj /adv.
- ⊕ Use: We use these structures to say that
 something is changing continuously and increasingly.

II. Grammar: Double comparison

3 : Cause and effect .

The brighter the sun is, the happier I feel.

Cause effect

The comparative+S+V, the comparative+S+V.

Use: We use these structures to say about a change in one thing causing a change in another.

4: Some elliptical forms

Eg: The brighter, the better.

Eg: The more, the better.

Form:

The comparative+(S+V), the comparative+(S+V).
